Speaker: Joe Dudley – Sales Engineer for KE2 Therm Solutions, Inc.

Joe holds a BS in Engineering Mgt from the U of MO-Rolla and has worked in the HVACR industry for over 10 yrs He's held positions of Sales Engineer, Regional Sales Manager, and Senior Application Engineer while working for Sporlan Valve, Tecumseh Products, and KE2 Therm Solutions in Washington, MO. He holds NATE certification and has presented several NATE courses.

Topic: Joe will present the **KE2 Evaporator Efficiency** controller that provides precise temperature control, adaptive defrost control, and monitoring/alarming for commercial refrigeration systems. This control is ideal for walk-in coolers and freezers, refrigerated warehouses, meat prep rooms, and blast freezers. The advanced control scheme delivers up to 40% energy savings over traditional mechanically controlled systems.

The **KE2 Temp + Defrost** controller will also be discussed. This device is designed to simplify refrigeration controls by combining the functions of a thermostat and defrost timeclock for cooler applications with off-time defrost. A robust design provides versatility for a wide range of applications including under-counter refrigerators, wine cabinets, reach-in refrigerators, and walk-in coolers.
